

The Stile Antico Foundation is seeking a Youth Trustee for a year's term intended to commence in March/April 2022.

About the role:

This is an excellent opportunity for a young professional or student to offer their own contribution and perspective to the operations of the Foundation, whilst also gaining valuable experience of charity governance within the music sector.

As a Youth Trustee of the Stile Antico Foundation, you must have:

- a commitment to the mission of the Stile Antico Foundation as defined in its charitable aims
- a willingness to meet the minimum time requirement
- integrity and independent judgement in order to scrutinise and evaluate the impact of the charity, ensuring that all activities are appropriate
- an ability to think creatively
- a willingness to speak your mind and contribute to strategic vision in line with good practice
- an understanding and acceptance of the legal duties, responsibilities and liabilities of trusteeship
- good communication and interpersonal skills, and an ability to work effectively as a member of a team and to take decisions for the good of the Stile Antico Foundation

Age requirement:

Applicants for this Youth Trustee position should be aged between 21 and 28 years old as of April 2022. Exceptional candidates outside of this age range may be considered.

Location and voluntary time commitment:

- Quarterly board meetings are held virtually and/or in-person in London for approximately two hours. These meetings take place out of office hours.
- In addition to the quarterly meetings, Trustees contribute their time towards activities of the Foundation (eg. fundraising/finances/administrative duties/ minute-taking/information management/governance etc) on an ad hoc basis as appropriate.

About us:

Launched in 2014, the Stile Antico Foundation is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) dedicated to the advancement and nurturing of choral music. The Foundation, which is financially and structurally independent of Stile Antico, seeks to increase knowledge and appreciation of choral music in several ways:

- by supporting performances and the development of new programmes, principally, though not exclusively, by Stile Antico;
- by supporting workshops and educational projects designed to promote appreciation of choral music at little or no cost to participants;

- by making possible the publication of musical editions and scholarly articles.

The Foundation administers the Friends of Stile Antico, enabling it to make grants to Stile Antico and others in line with these aims, including supporting new programmes, educational initiatives, the publishing of Stile Antico editions, bursaries for musicians and the commissioning of new works.
